

## **PE and Sports Funding Report 2014- 2015**

Over the course of the academic year 2014- 2015, Sea Mills Primary School received £8, 845 as a part of the government funding initiative- The PE and Sports Premium. This funding is as a result of the London 2012 Olympics and aims to improve the quality, variety and general provision of PE in Primary schools. At Sea Mills Primary school, this funding has been used to improve the variety of curriculum and sporting opportunities for children during school time and through after school sports clubs.

### **Superstars- Curriculum**

An outside agency of fully qualified sport coaches was used in order to high quality skills based lessons. These lessons were observed regularly in order to monitor their impact and ensure their quality. All lessons were observed to be of a good quality, where children enthusiastically took part and were able to demonstrate their understanding of team work and skills through discussions with the teacher.

### **Superstars- After School sports clubs**

This outside agency was also used in order to deliver a wide range of sporting clubs after school for children from Year 1 up to Year 6. Children have taken ownership of this and were able to suggest possible focuses for each term. This meant that a large majority of the clubs were to maximum capacity and the love of physical activity continued after school.

### **Oasis Brightside Sport Festival**

The role of this was to improve links between primary and secondary schools by providing opportunities for Key Stage two children to take part in competitive sporting activities. A range of children in Key Stage two took part in the following activities with schools in our cluster; basketball, athletics, rounders, football and tag rugby.

Overall the investment of this funding has had a positive impact at Sea Mills Primary School. The school are able to promote a well-rounded and healthy lifestyle, as a result children are embracing this and are developing a life-long love of physical activity.
