Home Learning Procedure  
May 2022



### **Rationale and tasks:**

Home learning activities are an important part of the home/school partnership, which enhance and support children's work in class.

Each week, children will receive the following home learning:

Reception: Daily reading, phoneme of the week or suggested activities for learning at home

Year 1 and 2: Daily reading, number bonds/times table practise, spelling

Year 3 and 4: Daily reading, times table practise, spelling

Year 5 and 6: Daily reading, times table practise, spelling (and specific SATs revision for Y6)

Children in Years 1-6 will be given 8-10 spellings per week and a specific times table they will need to be focusing on. Tasks should be differentiated and reflect the needs of the child.

### **Roles and responsibilities**

- Spelling overviews are sent home termly and are available on the class pages.
- Teachers will check home-reading records at least weekly to ensure reading at home is happening and contact families if it is not.
- Discussions may take place with families if a child is repeatedly not doing their home learning to find a way of supporting the child in completing their home learning.
