As **Authors**, we will be using exploring traditional tales. We will retell stories such as Goldilocks and the three bears and Little Red Riding Hood. We will practice writing letters in the role of one of the characters. When writing we will continue to focus on forming letters correctly, sitting our letters on the line and remembering to use finger spaces between words.
