Early Pick Up

We have noticed an increasing number of parents requesting an early pick up. Please only do so if you have a prior arrangement as it is a very busy time of the day for the office and it is also disruptive to the children's story time.

Scooters and Small World Play

If you are having a clear out before Christmas and have any old but functional scooters, small word play, plastic animals or dinosaurs or construction toys then we could make great use of them at break and lunchtime. Please bring them in to the office.

Nails, Jewellery and Make up

There has been a noticeable improvement in the consistency of children wearing full school uniform; thank you for your support. Remember there is good quality, clean uniform in the reception for free if you are running short. Can't find the right size? We have more in storage so please ask. Some children are wearing false nails, jewellery or make up to school which is not allowed. Please remind your children.

Smoking at the end of the lane

Please avoid smoking or vaping at the end of the lane on the approach to school. Whilst this is a public space it would be very much appreciated if this is smoke free so children don't need to walk through this on their way in.

No phones at the disco please!

A reminder that children are not allowed to have phones at the disco and a request that parent's refrain from using them too. This is to keep all our children safe and ensure that photos aren't shared without permission.
